Conducted at the State War Memorial in Fraser Avenue. Large screens have been erected to show historic footage and the Dawn Service and commences at 4.15 am. Please note no vehicle entry via Frasers Avenue and there is limited parking available. Please allow for delayed entry to and exit from Kings Park.

## ANZAC Day March (9.30 am)

### PLEASE NOTE: Change of Parade Route for 2012

Australian Defence Forces will step off from the corner of William Street and St Georges Terrace at 9.30 am, followed by veteran carrying vehicles, and the Ex-Service Unit, Corps, Regimental Associations. Parade will march east along St Georges Terrace, turn right onto Barrack Street, left onto Riverside Drive, and left onto the Supreme Court Gardens.

The salute (to the right) will be taken at the saluting dais opposite Trinity Church. The Reviewing Officer is the Governor of Western Australia, His Excellency Mr Malcolm McCusker AC CVO QC.

## ANZAC Day Service (11.00 am)

### PLEASE NOTE: Service will be on Supreme Court Gardens in 2012

The Parade will enter Supreme Court Gardens off Riverside Drive and form up facing west. The service will commence at 11.00 am.

covered areas on the reserve. Toilet facilities will be available on both sides of the reserve.

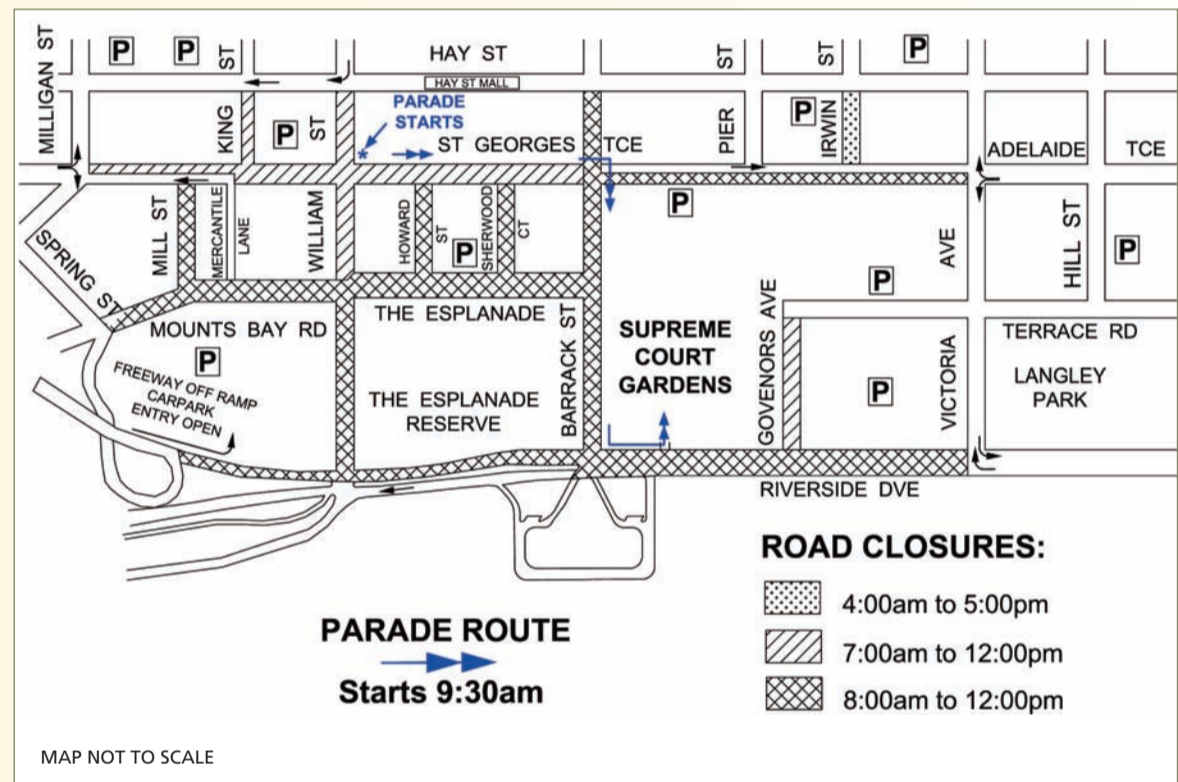
## CBD Parking

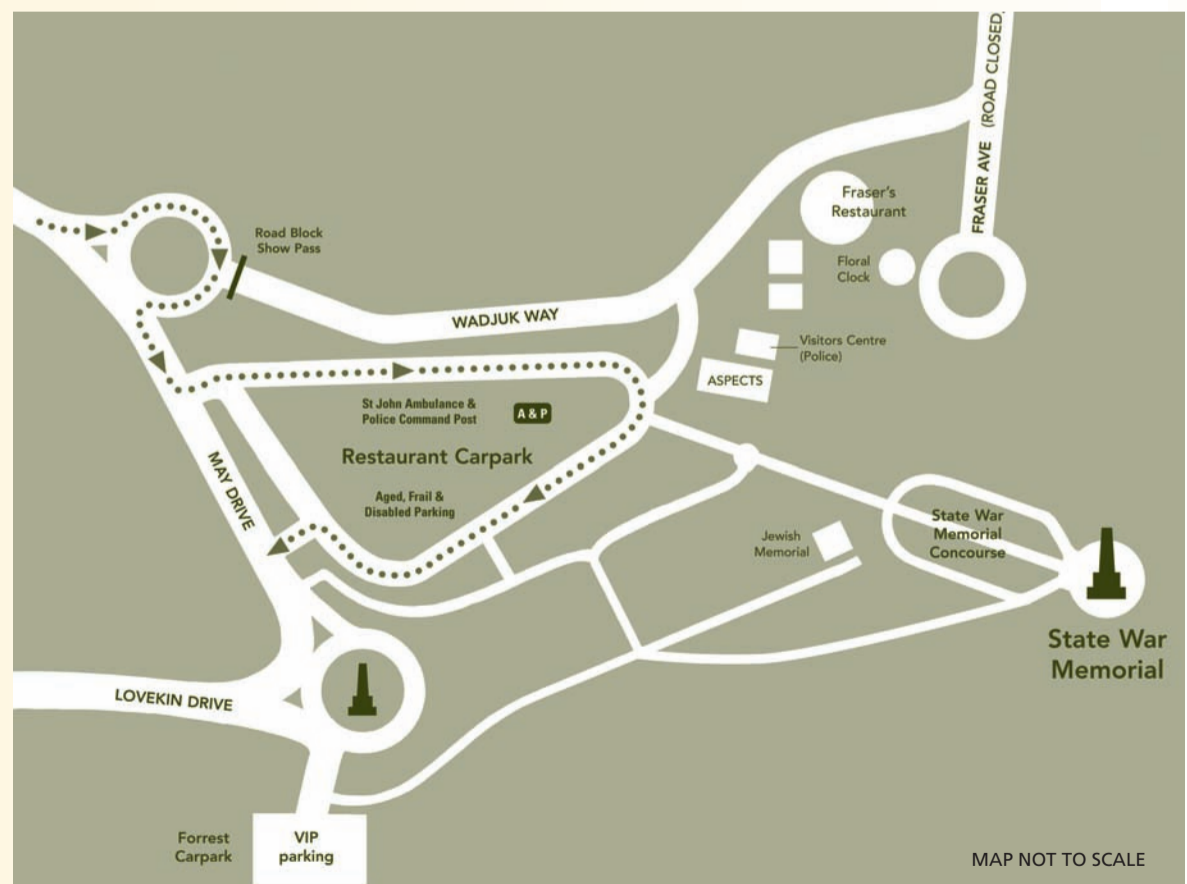
## ANZAC Club

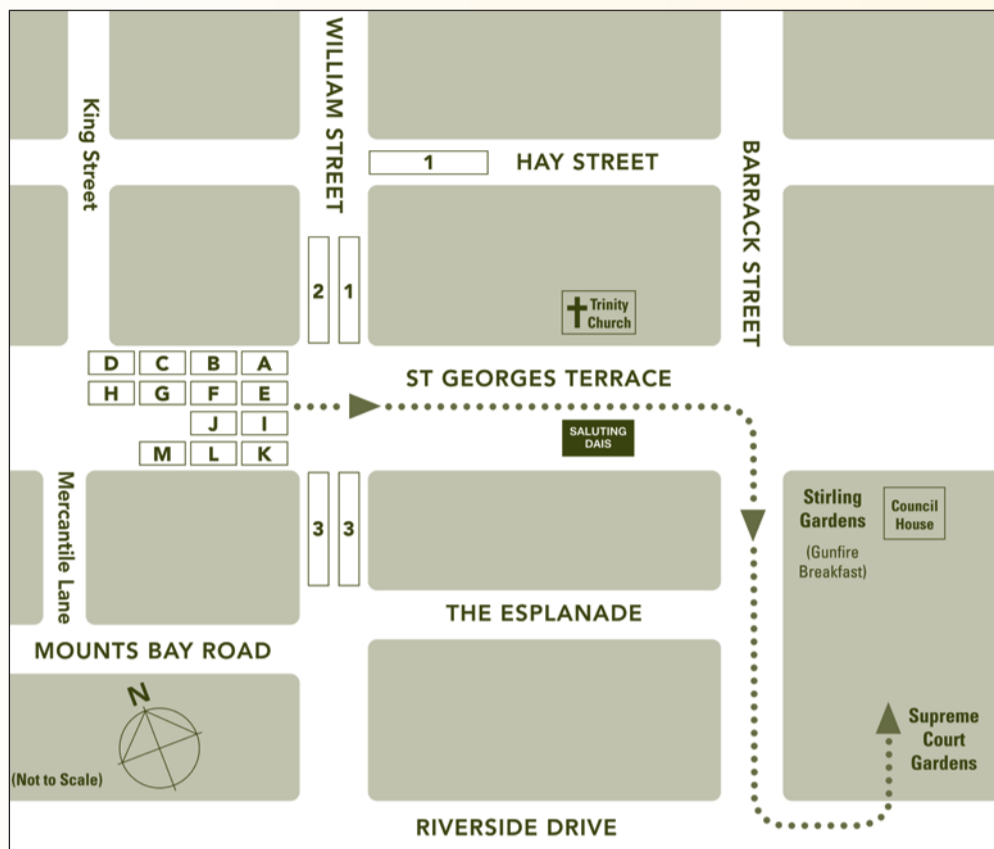
## City Road Closures - Please note change of parade route
