

The vessel now looks like the ship her designers had expected her to become following the recent installation of the Australian-made superstructure blocks on the massive hull.



The Silver Legacy Resort Casino is located at 407 North Virginia Street, Reno, NV 89501. The hotel is approximately 5 miles from the Reno Tahoe International Airport off of Highway 80. If you are driving, please call the hotel directly for directions. The Silver Legacy has many amenities that include: LuLu, a full service hair salon, Adventure Desk, perfect for guests looking to enjoy outdoor activities, Segway and Harley rentals, and Shopping - all under one roof. The Silver Legacy also offers guests access to their outdoor heated pool and whirlpool bath. The hotel's fitness center is located inside their Health Spa. Each newly renovated guest room features an iron/ironing board and a hairdryer. The hotel offers handicapped accessible rooms, which are based on availability. Please make this request when making your reservation. The Silver Legacy Resort Casino offers smoking and non-smoking rooms. Parking is complimentary. Check-in time is 3pm; check-out is at 11am. SIPS Coffee and Tea is open from 6am daily. Flavors! The Buffet is open for breakfast, lunch, or dinner. Fresh Express Food Court is open Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Fairchild's Oyster Bar is open for lunch and dinner from 11am daily. Sterling's Seafood Steakhouse is open from 5pm nightly, reservations are recommended.

As part of the \$8 resort fee, the hotel offers their guests complimentary airport shuttle service from 5am-Midnight daily; the service runs every half hour. Upon your arrival at the airport, proceed to the baggage claim area and follow the signage directing you to the general airport shuttle area. In addition to the airport shuttle, the resort fee covers such things as guestroom internet access, parking, unlimited local and toll-free calls, fitness center access, and various coupons.

The hotel has RV parking for guests staying at the hotel. Your RV will be stored on 5th Street, about a block away from the hotel, locked up and under surveillance. There is a shuttle service that will take you to and from the RV parking lot. For full hookup services, the Reno RV Park is located at 735 Mill Street, Reno, Nevada 89502 which is approximately 1 mile from the hotel. Call the park at (775) 323-3381 or (800) 445-3381 for information, directions, or reservations.

Should you need to rent a wheelchair for the reunion, the hotel provides them on limited availability only - on a first come, first serve basis. If a wheelchair is available, Silver Legacy requires a driver's license or credit card to be left with the Bell Desk while the chair is in use. The driver's license or credit card will be returned when the chair is brought back. There is no charge for the use of wheelchairs. Advanced reservations are welcome through the Bell Desk. ScootAround also rents both manual and power wheelchairs by the day and week. Please call their toll free number at (888) 441-7575 for details.

LAKE TAHOE / LUNCH CRUISE

Thursday October 3
